Mark the days that the student will be attending. Students are then enrolled for the upcoming month.

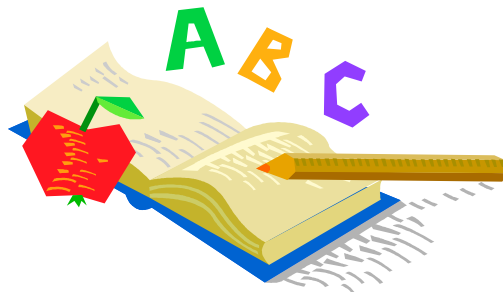
If a student is enrolled, but cannot attend because of another activity or conflict:

- d. tell us in person prior to that day

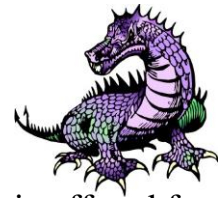
For the all student's safety, a student can only be released from the After School Program by using the above protocol.

What is Provided



The After School Program is offered for students kindergarten through sixth grade. The program begins after Labor Day and is offered Monday through Thursday until the end of April. After School Program hours are from 3:35- until 5:00.

Students will always be supervised by an adult staff member.

Students will receive supervision and assistance with homework at no cost to the parent.

Supervised High School Students also help provide assistance with the program.

Students receive additional practice in reading, writing, math, and study skills.

A healthy snack is offered to all students at no cost. If your student has special dietary needs or allergies, please let us know.

Games, crafts, and special activities are occasionally planned.

Outside play time (weather permitting), if homework is completed.
